

EYE DISSECTION STATEMENT

Please read this statement before booking to attend the Eye Dissection Demonstration (available as part of Light Days for Key Stage 2).

It is compulsory that the group leader confirms that they have read this form and ticks the box on the booking form before they attend the session.

By ticking the box on the booking form, you are confirming that:

- You are responsible for the group
- You agree that your group will watch the eye dissection at the National Science and Media Museum
- You understand this event includes a live dissection of a sheep eyeball
- You are aware that this event is advertised as suitable for 7+ due to the nature of the event and the content
- You take full responsibility for the admittance of under-7s and it is at your discretion
- You are aware that a large screen in the room will be used to transmit the dissection

Further details of the demonstration are as follows:

- The eye dissection will take place in a classroom at the museum
- The group will be warned that a live eye dissection will take place before the event starts
- Any member of the group wishing to leave the room before or during the dissection will be able to do so and should be accompanied by a member of school staff. Please ensure that you have enough staff to accompany students wishing to leave the room as well as staff to remain in the room with the group
- The group will not be able to touch or handle the eye or any part of it
- Sharp instruments will be used within this demonstration—please make sure that the group is supervised at all times
