**I'm going to the National Science
and Media Museum.**

On Saturday 3 June, I'm going to the National Science and Media Museum's Bradford Science Festival.



When I arrive, I will go to the front desk to scan my ticket. I will be given a piece of paper with information about activities in the museum.



It might be busy in the foyer, at certain times of the day I can see big puppets there.



**The museum might be busy or loud. I can ask for
ear defenders at the front desk.**



I can find my way around the museum using the map at the bottom of the stairs.



I will use the steps or the lift to move to different levels of the museum.



If I need to use the toilet, I can find them on the ground floor, Level 3 and Level 5. There are accessible toilets on the ground floor and Level 3 and Level 5.



There is a Changing Places toilet on the ground floor. I can access this by asking a person at Control for a key or using my own.



If I need a quiet space during my visit, I can go to the Quiet Room on the ground floor. It is a light room and there are screens I can go behind. Sometimes people pray in this room.



**I can choose other galleries I want to go to.
Maps will help me choose.**



There are activities happening in Kodak Gallery on level -1. If I want to, I can make a flip book or listen to a story at 4.30pm.



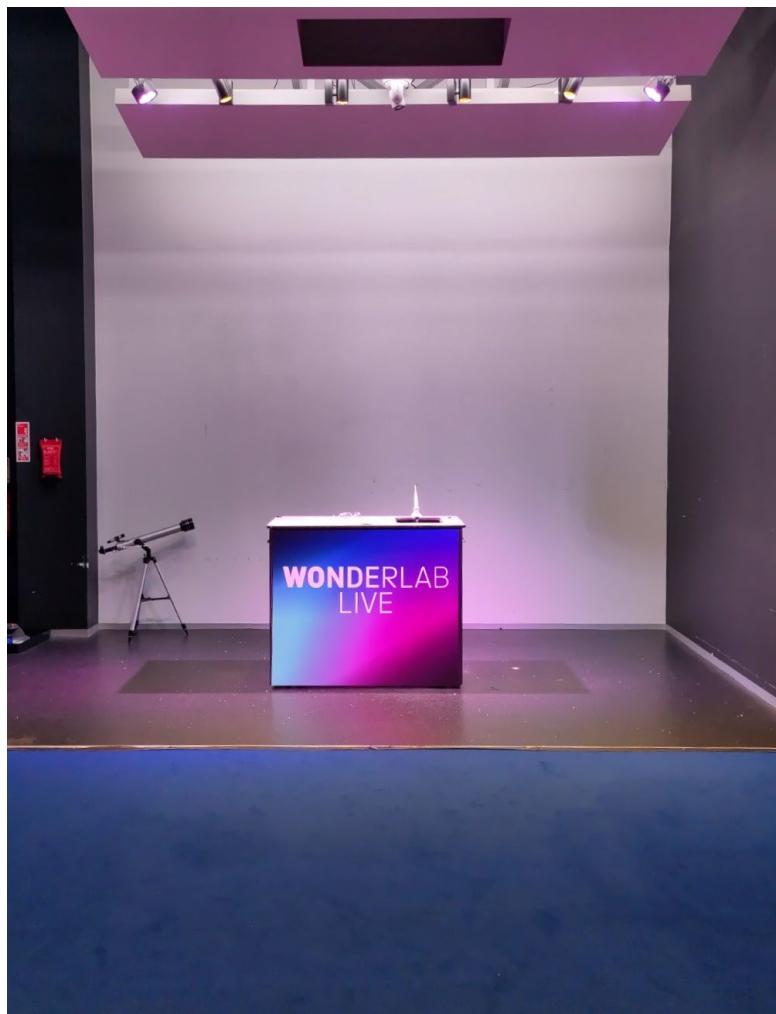
I can visit Giant Leaps on Level 1 and take part in a movement workshop at 4.00pm. This gallery has music and low lighting. Other people are likely to be in here as well.



There are activities about space in Gallery 2 on level 2. I can listen to a talk about the Orion spacecraft at 4.30pm.



There is a Science Show in the Wonderlab Studio on Level 3. This show has a loud bang and is in a room with low lighting. It has a BSL Interpreter. If I want to, I can watch this show at 4:30pm.



The museum closes at 5:00pm. I will leave the museum at closing time. If I used ear defenders, I will give them back at the front desk.
